




An Introduction to Acoustical Holography (Paperback)

Upatnieks on the subject of holography appeared in 1961, there has been a virtual explosion of research activity in the field. More than SOO papers and articles on holo- graphy have appeared in the last ten years. The first papers on this subject appeared in 1966. but already research activity in the field is burgeoning. The purpose of this book is to bring together the results of research in acoustical holography, some of it as yet unpublished, under one cover so that workers in holography, nondestructive testing, medical imaging, underwater imaging, and seismic exploration can decide whether this new technique can be useful to them.
