

Excerpt from Agricultural Gazette of Canada, Vol. 9 In the late summer of 1906 the Experimental Station at Lethbridge, Alberta, designed to serve the southern part of the province, was established. It is located three miles east of the business centre of the city of Lethbridge, and is traversed by the Crow s Nest branch of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company s line. Owing to the extensive irrigation development that had already begun at that time in southern Alberta, the need for experimental work in connection with farming carried on under irrigation was recognized, and the farm was selected so that a part of it could be irrigated and the balance could be devoted to experimental work with non-irrigated or dry land farming. As a matter of fact, it could almost be said that two experimental farms were established, for the work on the dry and irrigated parts of the farm are quite distinct and have always been kept separate. Their object being not to compare the relative merits of the two systems but to study the...
