

Enclosure. U. S. S. New Ironsides, Off Morris Island, July 30, 1863. Sir: I have the honor to report the following amount of damage sustained by this ship, during the bombardment of the rebel Battery Gregg this day. One shot hit direct above No. 6 port, on upper edge of iron plating, slightly cracking it on the inside; this broke the shot into fragments, pieces of it glancing up, going through woodwork, and striking the chain round the turret, cut it in two. Another shot passed over from port side, aft the turret, went through main stanchion, and cut main rail in two. I am. very respectfully, vour obedient servant, T. H. Bishop, Carpenter. Captain S. C. Rowan, Commanding New Ironside. Telegram. July 30, 1863—8 a. in. The enemy firing musketry from Fort Wagner and interferes with my working. Can you...
