Her parents, Eleanor Lothrop and Warren Edward Wilkins, originally baptized her Mary Ella. They were orthodox Congregationalists and brought Mary up very strictly, a theme which Mary used in her works throughout her career. The family moved to Brattleboro, Vermont, in 1867, from where Mary graduated from the local high school before continuing her education at Mount Holyoke Female Seminary in South Hadley, Massachusetts, for the year 1870-71. She later finished her education at Glenwood Seminary in West Brattleboro. The family went through straitened times in 1873 when their dry-goods store closed down and the family returned to Randolph. Mary s mother died in 1876 and in her memory Mary added Eleanor to her name. She had begun writing verse and stories for children whilst still a teenager and these early submissions proved successful. Her first short story to be published was The Ghost Story in 1881 after it won a short story competition. By interlacing elements of the supernatural with domestic realism she had hit upon a solid formula for...
