

Excerpt from Ohio University Bulletin, Vol. 1: December, 1893 Between 1880 and 1889 the annual ap propriations were nearly twelve million francs. Some of this came from the universities in the form of endowments and fees of various kinds, but the revenue from this source never amounted to one third of the expenditures. In addition to these annual grants there were expended during the years above named, about 99, francs for new buildings, of which was contributed by the State, somewhat more than by cities, and the balance - less than one million francs - by the departments. There is considerable difference in the liberality exhibited by the cities. Bordeaux, for instance, expended about three millions and received less than one million sub vention. Lyons appropriated more than seven million francs and received but two from the general government. All France has shared in this spirit of restoration and reconstruction. Paris, as would be ex pected, takes the lead, and the new Sor bonne is one of the ornaments of the city; next in order come Bordeaux and Lyons. At Besancon a new...
