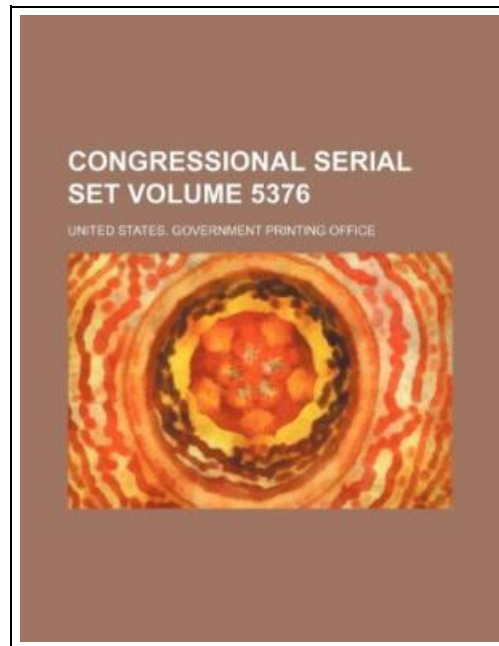

During the late civil war the military forces of the United States, for their use, took possession of the church building described in the petition at or about the time of the battle of Perryville and used the same at intervals for a period of about two years. The building was first used as a hospital and afterwards as a barracks, and later was a fort for the troops, and while so used and occupied by the military forces of the United States as a fort was fired upon by the Confederate forces under the late Gen. John H. Morgan and the roof and cupola of the church materially damaged, but the extent thereof does not appear. The reasonable rental value of the church building during such occupancy, together with the damages thereto caused by the military forces of the United States (independently of any damage caused by said Confederate forces under General Morgan), in excess of ordinary wear and tear, was the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (1, 500), of which amount it appears that the claimant has been paid the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars (120), leaving thirteen hundred and eighty dollars (1, 380) due on account of the use and occupation by the United States military forces and for the damages occasioned by said use and occupation.
