In Canto i of the same Book, stanza 6, the same word ooours in oonnexion with bag instead of scrip: Behind her farre away a Dwarfe did lag, That lazie seem d in beeine ener last, Or wearied with bearing of her bag Of needments at his back. Oddments and needments are not wholly obsolete...
