The gross income during the calendar year 1929 decreased as compared with 1928. This indicates a loss of A factor to be considered in comparing figures for the two years is the fact that 1928, a leap year, had one more day than 1929. Mak ing allowance for the additional leap year day makes the percentage decrease in gross income The task of the Boston Elevated Railway is to move large numbers of people to and from their work and about their business, particularly in the rush hours of morning and evening.
