

For example, studies have found a 2-to 3-month time lag from the beginning of the school year in getting students matched with mentors (Hansen, 2005, Herrera, et al. , 2000; Karcher, 2008) so that actual mentoring takes place for a period of 5 to 6 months for approximately 6 hours a month (Herrera, et al. , 2000). In addition, the school-based approach has often relied heavily on high-school and college-age mentors, which, on one hand, increases the number of students a program can serve, but also can limit the length of the mentoring relationship given the mentors inability to commit beyond a semester or school year (Herrera et al. , 2007).
