This compares favorably with last year's crop which was estimated at pounds. There is a tendency toward devoting more attention to tobacco in Porto Rico. It is estimated that about 30 per cent of the crop is made into cigars and cigarettes, the remainder being shipped in the leaf. The United States takes nearly all of the surplus crop.
