Alternative circular routes, are provided for car users with detailed advice on reaching the walk locations. Most of the walks are not arduous and are on paths in the most beautiful, historical and interesting parts of this very diverse region, ranging from the coastlines of the Wirral, Sefton, and the Mersey, the valleys of Lancashire and Greater Manchester with their canals and reservoirs, and Dark Peak District of the Pennines. Points of interest are noted including historical places, flora and fauna and places for refreshment.
