That the rule, known as the State Quota, according to which appointments in the foreign service are distributed among the States in proportion to the number of inhabitants, be abolished. 5. That political considerations be entirely eliminated and that the merit principle be applied to appointments and promotions in the foreign service, and in particular (a) That the President be urged to fill the post of Minister by the promotion of capable officers in the foreign service and that when a vacancy occurs the Secretary of State be required to submit to the President for his consideration the names of secretaries and consuls who merit promotion. (b) That ministers be appointed to that grade and not to a specific post. (c) That the President be urged, in so far as practicable, to promote ministers to embassies when vacant. (d) That examinations be held every year for those who wish to be transferred from the consular to...
