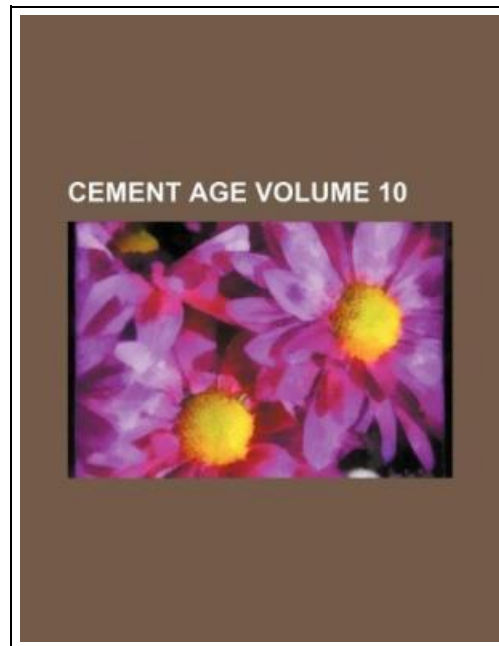

Only plain letters that can be quickly made and easily read should be used by architects. Engineers and builders will then have no trouble in making out their meaning and are not nearly so liable to make mistakes.
