




## The History of Dings Crusaders Rugby Club: A Club with its Heart in Bristol (Paperback)

The club s move to Lockleaze in 1948 established close links with the local community and schools, and the publication of this history coincides with Dings Crusaders move to a new home, Shaftesbury Park, heralding an exciting new chapter in the club s story.
