




A Family Secret: A Graphic Novel of Courage and Resistance Brought to You by the

Helena then has to explain to her grandson that her father was a Nazi collaborator, and actually sent Esther and her family to a concentration camp, for which she never forgave him. But a chance meeting for Jeroen reveals that Helena didn't yet know the whole story about her fatheror the real fate of Estherin this companion story to The Search. Published by the Anne Frank House, with the Jewish Historical Museum in Amsterdam, this graphic novel is part of a series for readers 9 and up that relates the history of the Holocaustfor the victims and the survivorsthrough the personal stories of individual families.
