The society soon after appointed a committee to act in connection with that of the church. This joint committee issued an invitation by circular to all former members, and all absent members of the church and society, so far as their residences could be ascertained. In reply, many letters accepting the invitation, and many expressing regrets at inability to be present, and a gratifying interest in the church as well as pastor, were received.
