The Regression Coefficients Of Index Of Agricultural Efficiency On Indices Of Area Under Irrigation, Per Hectare Availability Of Institutional Credit, Per Hectare Consumption Of Fertilisers, Area Under Hyvs, Pesticides Consumption And Tractorisation Have Been Found Positive And Statistically Significant.
