




Pete Maravich: Magician of the Hardwood

A magician at handling or shooting the ball and the most prolific scorer in college basketball history, Pistol Pete was as recognizable as he was flashy. If the mop of brown hair and floppy gray socks didnt give him away, the behind-the-back dribbling and between the-legs passes did. Maravich first captured the nations attention while playing basketball for his father at Louisiana State University, averaging an incredible 44. 2 points per game over three years and earning college player-of-the-year honors in 1970. He went on to play for ten years in the NBA for the Atlanta Hawks, New, Orleans Jazz, and Boston Celtics, garnering NBA First Team honors twice and Second Team honors two other times. In 1976-77 he led the league in scoring with an average of 31. 1 points, including a 68-point outburst in a game against the New York Knicks.
