She encounters various different people, gaining new experiences and confronting many of the moral issues of the day. In 1921 the film was turned into a silent British film All Roads Lead to Calvary directed by Kenelm Foss. Jerome Klapka Jerome (2 May 1859 14 June 1927) was an English writer and humourist, best known for the comic travelogue Three Men in a Boat (1887). Other works include the essay collections Idle Thoughts of an Idle Fellow (1886) and Second Thoughts of an Idle Fellow; Three Men on the Bummel, a sequel to Three Men in a Boat (Packing for the journey); and several other novels.
