

At the start of the twenty-first century, Cairo's cityscape has acquired a spectacular global touch. It explores how young middle-class professionals navigate Cairo's increasingly divided landscape and discusses the rise of a young upper-middle class presence in the work, leisure, and public spaces of the city.
