

Women and Fiction was first published in the U.S. in Forum Magazine, a prominent literary journal of the 1920 s It is the principle essay and title of a series of lectures Woolff delivered at Newnham College and Girton College, two women s colleges at Cambridge University in October 1928. This essay and the Lectures would eventually be published as A Room of One s Own in 1929. In this essay Woolf traces the reasons for the very limited achievements among women novelists through the centuries. Why did they fail? They failed because they were not financially independent; they failed because they were not intellectually free; they failed because they were denied the fullest worldly experience. Mrs. Woolf imagines what would have happened to a hypothetical sister of Shakespeare (who possessed all his genius) because she lived in the eighteenth century; she insists that, whatever her gifts, no woman in that age of wife-beating could have written the plays.
